

A. Patch Placement Guidelines

The STAR Touring & Riding Association is a proud organization, steeped in tradition, camaraderie, and a family values. Many of our members have elected to show their pride in membership by wearing the National Association colors (back patch and rockers). In order to establish a sense of uniformity, the STAR Touring & Riding Association has established the following guidelines for wearing of patches.

The patches may be sewn on your jacket however the most popular choice has been to sew the patches on a black leather vest. The styles of vest may vary, but the most commonly used are unadorned by fringe, Conchos, or additional coloring.

The large STAR Touring and Riding patch is to be sewn on the back of the vest, centered, leaving enough room for the chapter rocker (approximately two inches tall).

The Chapter Rocker patch will be sewn directly beneath the large back patch. There must not be any gap between the large back patch and chapter rocker. When done properly, the two patches will take on the appearance of one rocker.

The small arm patch should be sewn on the front of the vest over the left breast. Small rockers denoting your position within the chapter (President etc.) or bike names will be sewn under the small arm patch. Again, care must be taken to prevent gapping between the patches.

No patch will be placed or manufactured to fit above the STAR Touring & Riding Association logo. No other club patches may be worn on the chapter vest without prior approval from the Chapter President.

The right side of the vest front may be used for the attachment of ride pins.

B. Titles and Rockers

The following is a list of "official titles" used within the STAR Touring & Riding Association. All Chapters (old and new) must comply with their usage. There will be no exceptions.

C. Placement Guideline

The STAR back patch should be placed in the center of the back of the vest. The chapter rocker should be placed *flush to the bottom* of the back patch leaving no gap, which will give the appearance of a one-piece design. Wing patches (Vet Wing, LOS Wing, Tin Star Wing or Starfire Wing) may be placed either above or below the back patch and rocker. **No rocker or patch will be designed to fit flush at the top of the back patch. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The small STAR arm/vest patch should be placed on the left side of the chest in line with the center of the arm. The patch should be placed at a slight angle while lying flat. It is designed to be straight while the vest is on. Small rockers (bike name, chapter position or custom design) should be placed flush to the bottom of this patch, again leaving no gap. The arm/vest patch may also be put on the left sleeve of your jacket.

STAR Vets patch should be placed on the right side of the chest directly across from the arm/vest patch, and must be put on at a slight angle. The Branch of Service is

laser-cut to fit against the bottom of the patch. The bottom of this rocker should hang in line with the bottom of the vest.

Chapter patches can be placed on the left if you are not a STAR Vet; we have additional patches that may also be placed here. If you have the STAR Vet patch you may place, the chapter patch in a location of your choice keeping in mind the guidelines above.
